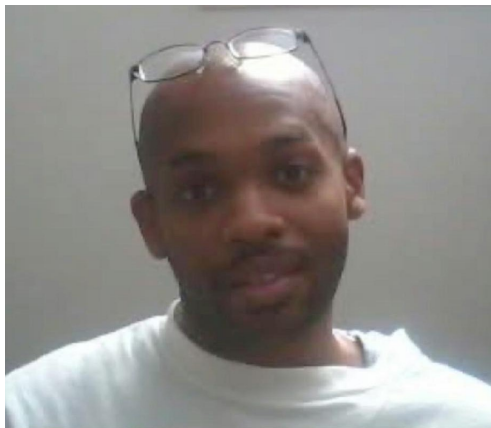
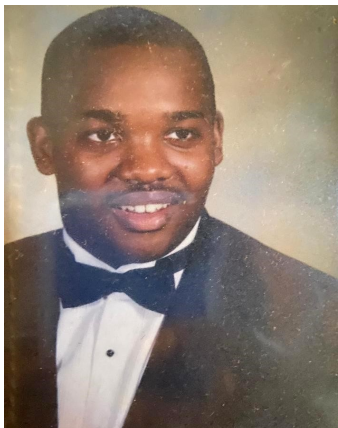




Joshua Rashaun “Josh” Brooks

Joshua was educated in Cleveland County Schools and proudly graduated from Burns High School in the Class of 1999.

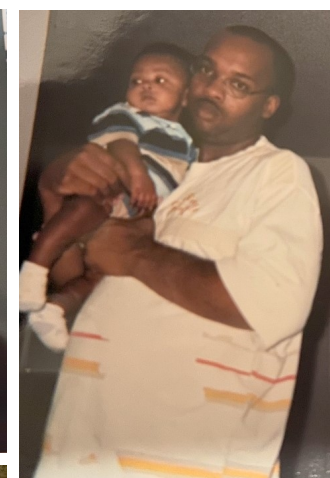
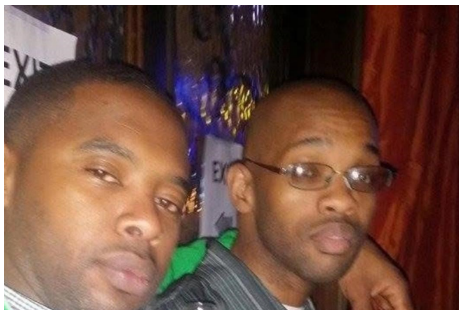
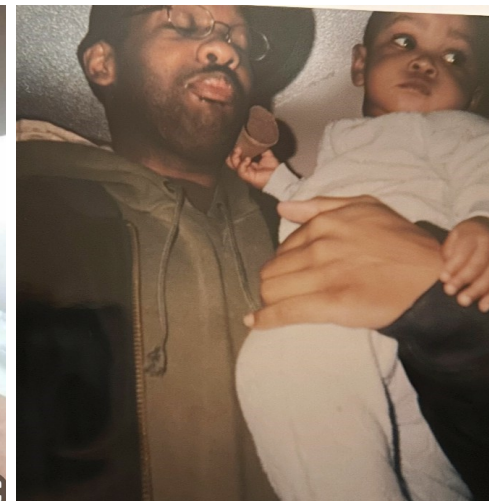
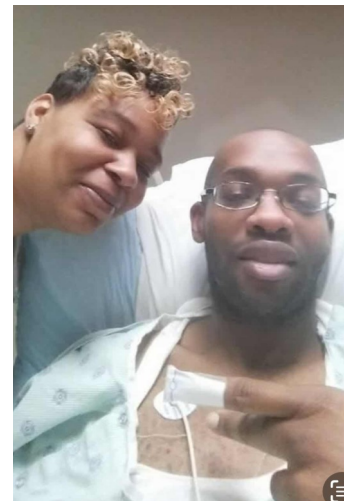
Throughout his life, he worked faithfully in various manufacturing jobs until his health declined.
