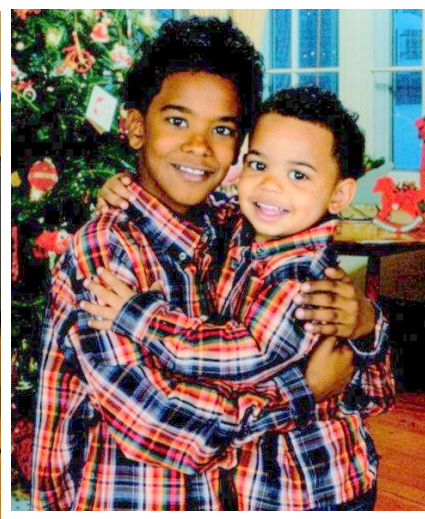
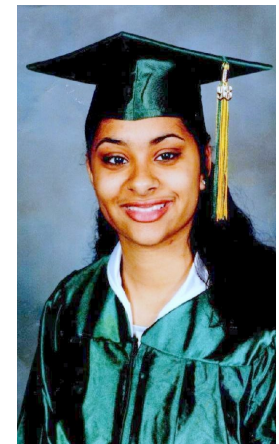

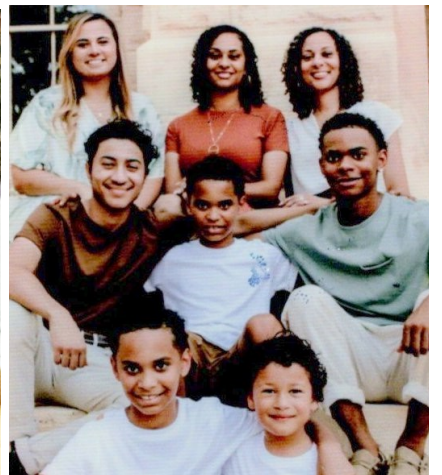
As We Look Back
