



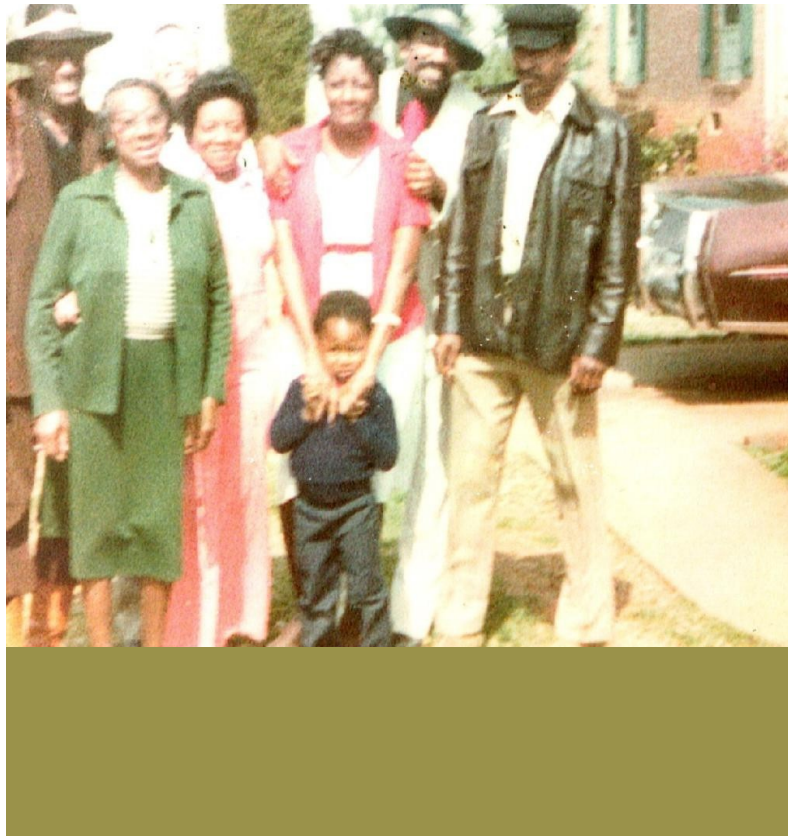
EDDIE CHAMBERS, JR.
