

Remembering Tiana

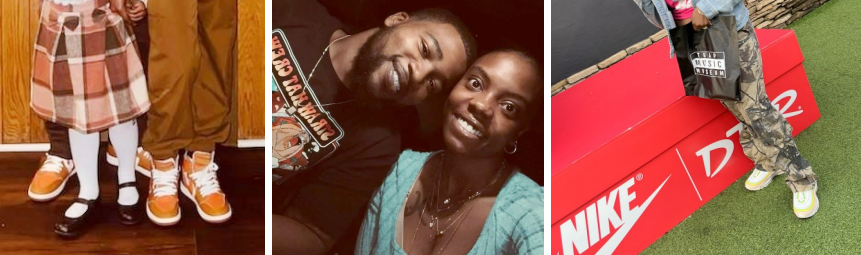
