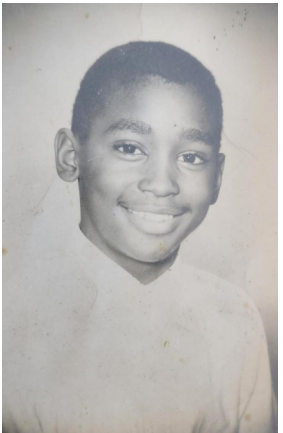

But celebrate my life.*



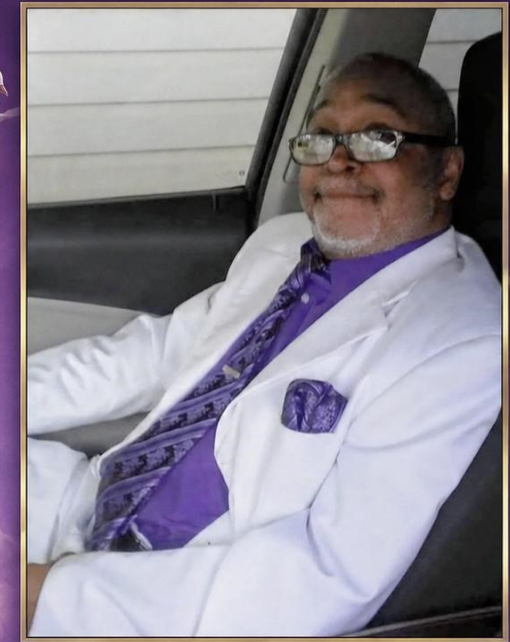
