# HIS LIFE STORY

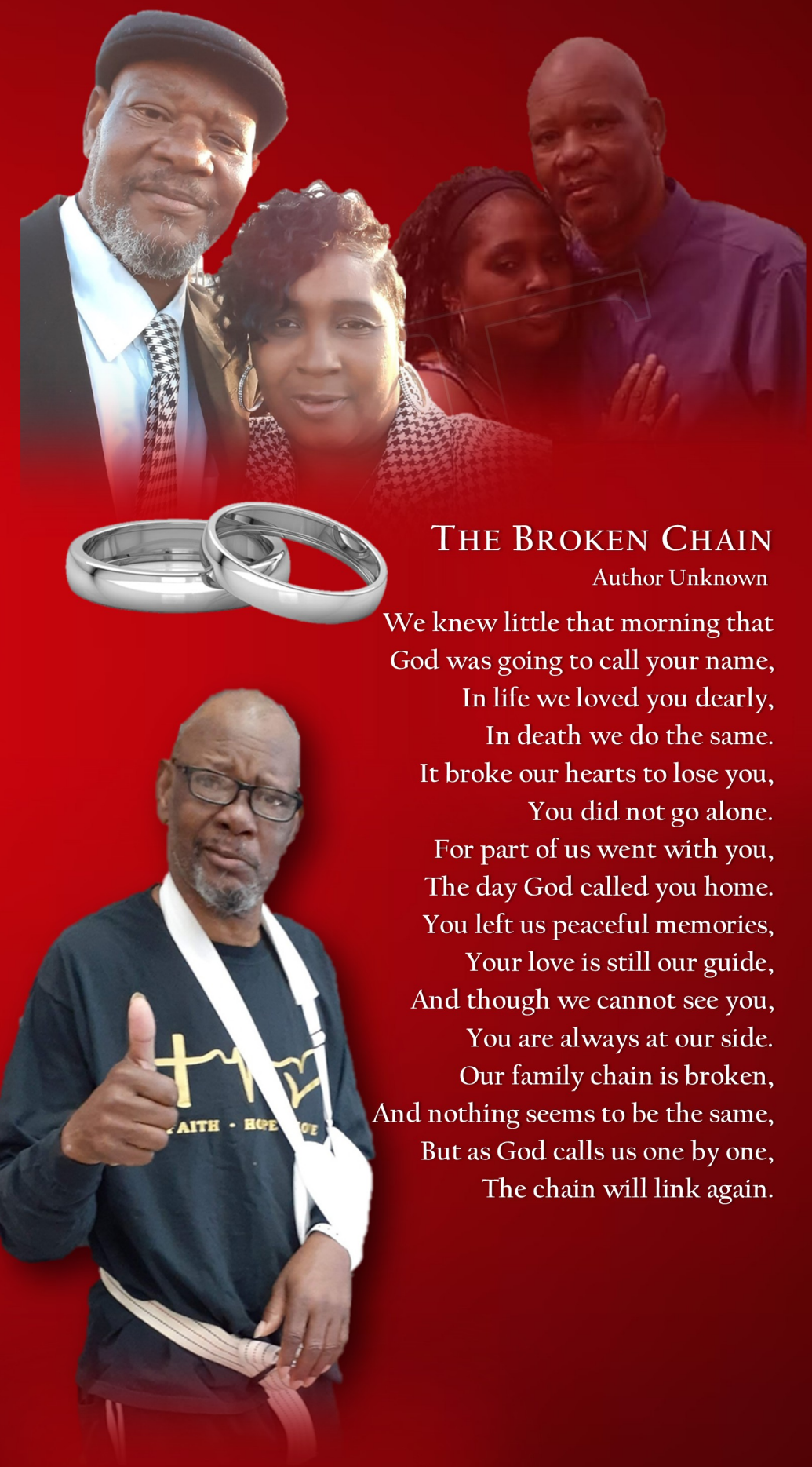
## Jeffrey "Pop Pop" Gaston
