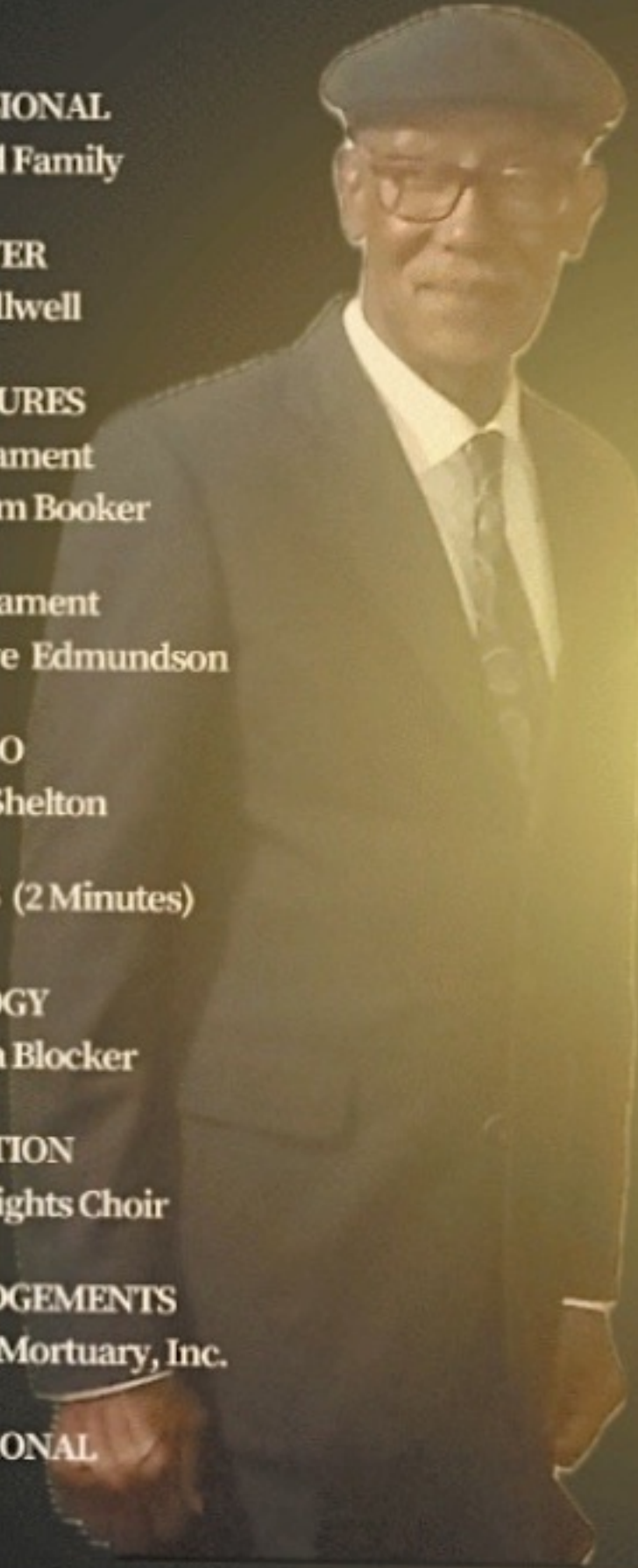

Percy Lee Lowe was born on May 20, 1935, in Sparta, GA, to Carlos and Edna Jones Lowe. Reared in the Culverton Community, he attended school at Bethlehem and L. S. Ingraham. He later attended technical school in Ohio. After completing technical school, he proudly served his country as a member of the United States Army. Following his time in the army, Percy relocated to Atlanta where he began a career at Ford Motor Company and raised his family.

Raised by God-fearing parents Percy, attended Bethlehem Baptist Church under the guidance of the Late Rev. Douglas Little. At an early age he received Christ as his Savior and was baptized at St. Galilee Baptist Church. Upon relocating to Atlanta Percy joined New Birth Church where he served faithfully under the guidance of the Late Rev. Johnny Harp. Through his faithful service Percy received the call to serve the Lord as a minister of the Gospel. He became a licensed minister and was later ordained by the elders of Word Over the World Church in Washington, D.C. Upon his return to Atlanta, he established and pastored Word Over the World Ministry which he served for twenty-five years. In 2014 he returned to his native Hancock County and established the Hancock Heights Ministry where he served until his passing.
