 whole again.*

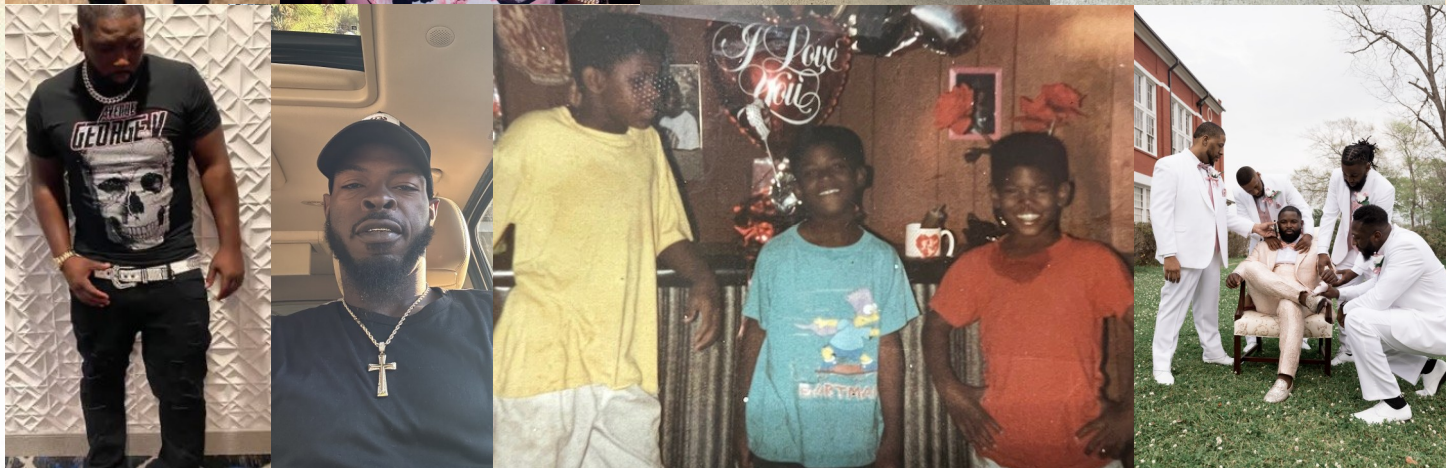
