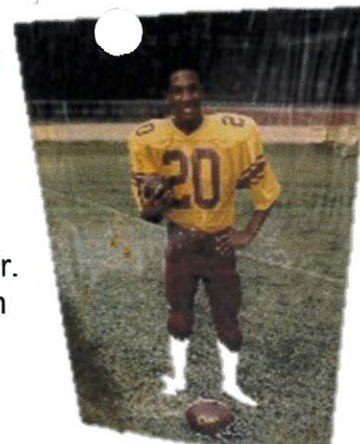
Tyrone was preceded in death by his wife Lynette Mitchell Green, and stepson, William Mitchell.
