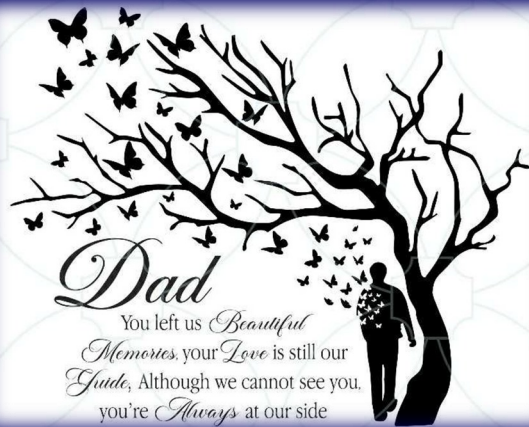


Uncle in Heaven
