

Obituary

Marshall was a great man of faith and humility. He was hardworking and a man of determination. He was passionate about singing and visiting family and friends.

Marshall was a member of Mt. Sinai Missionary Baptist Church where he was joyfully committed to his office as a Deacon. He was also a member of the Senior Choir and Male Chorus.


Marshall was a 1961 graduate of J.F. Drake High School in Auburn, Alabama. He was a 1977 graduate of Opelika State Technical College in Opelika, Alabama where he received his certification for Air Conditioning and Refrigeration. He was certified in 1993 by the American Real Estate Institute in Opelika, Alabama.

Marshall enlisted in the United States Army in 1961, stationed in Fort Jackson, South Carolina for Basic Combat Training. On May 27, 1966, he was a graduate of the United States Army Quartermaster School and Supply Training Center in Fort Lee, Virginia. Marshall was appointed to the rank of Sergeant in the Army of the United States on March 28th, 1967. He was honorably discharged from the US Army on July 31, 1969.

After his military duties, Marshall worked many years at Uniroyal BF Goodrich in Opelika, Alabama until his retirement. He also worked for many years at the East Alabama Mental Health Center in Opelika, Alabama.
