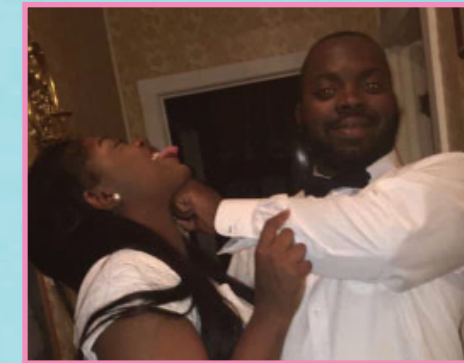
At an early age in life, she confessed Christ.

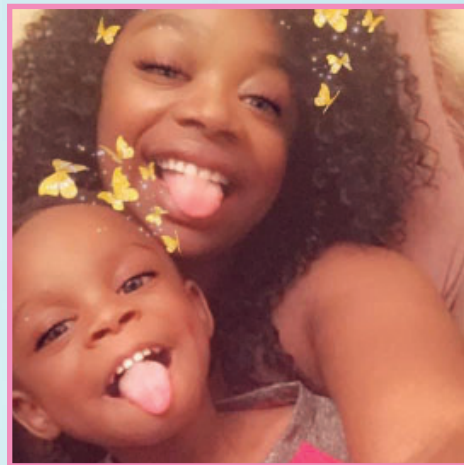

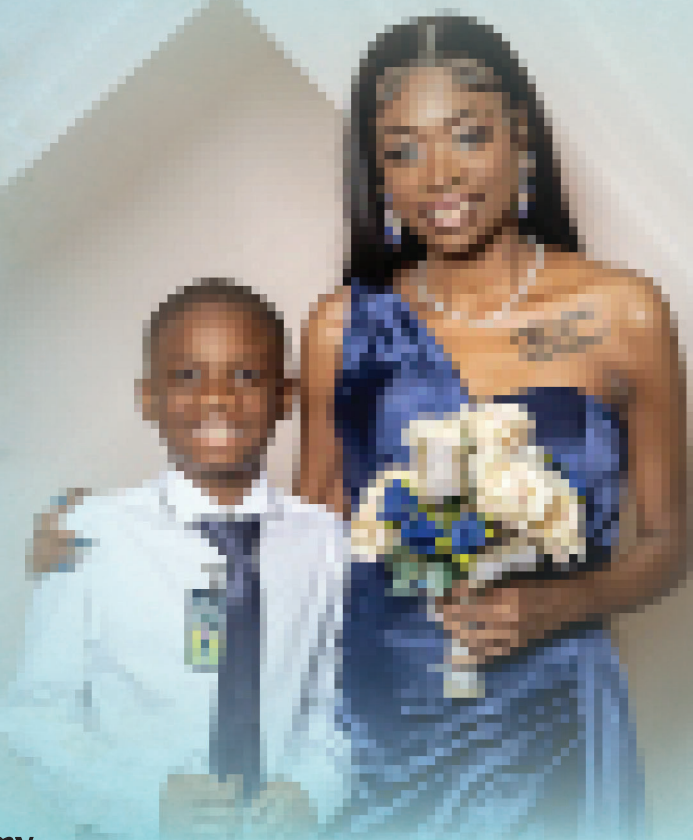
