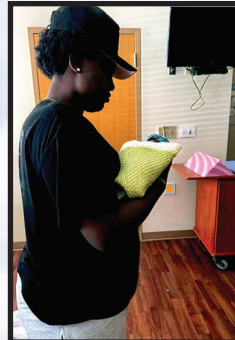
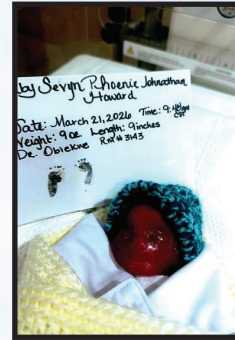
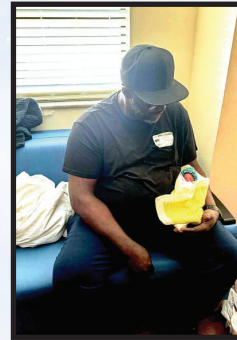
## - THE OBITUARY -
