Queen Ester Pollard confessed Christ and united with of Fitten Chapel A. M. E. Zion Church. In her spare time, she enjoyed gardening.

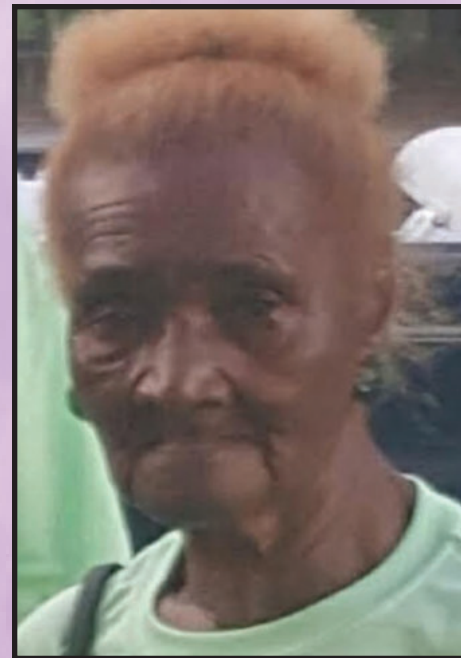
