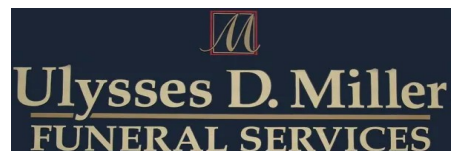


## *I'm Free!*
