Remember You

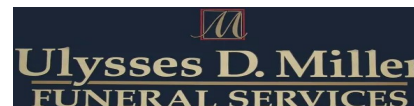
Mother we will remember you

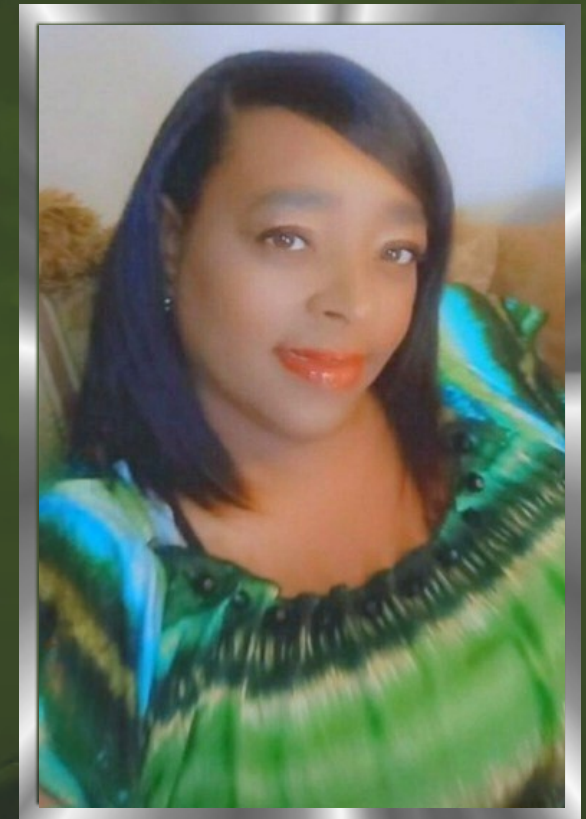
