Jimmy was born October 24, 1951, to Sally Mae Holly and Otis C. Harvey. He was the youngest of four children. In his early years, he attended the public schools of Terrell County, Georgia, where he graduated from Carver High in 1970. At an early age, he confessed his love for Christ and joined New Destiny Christian Church in Albany, GA, where he attended faithfully until his health failed.
