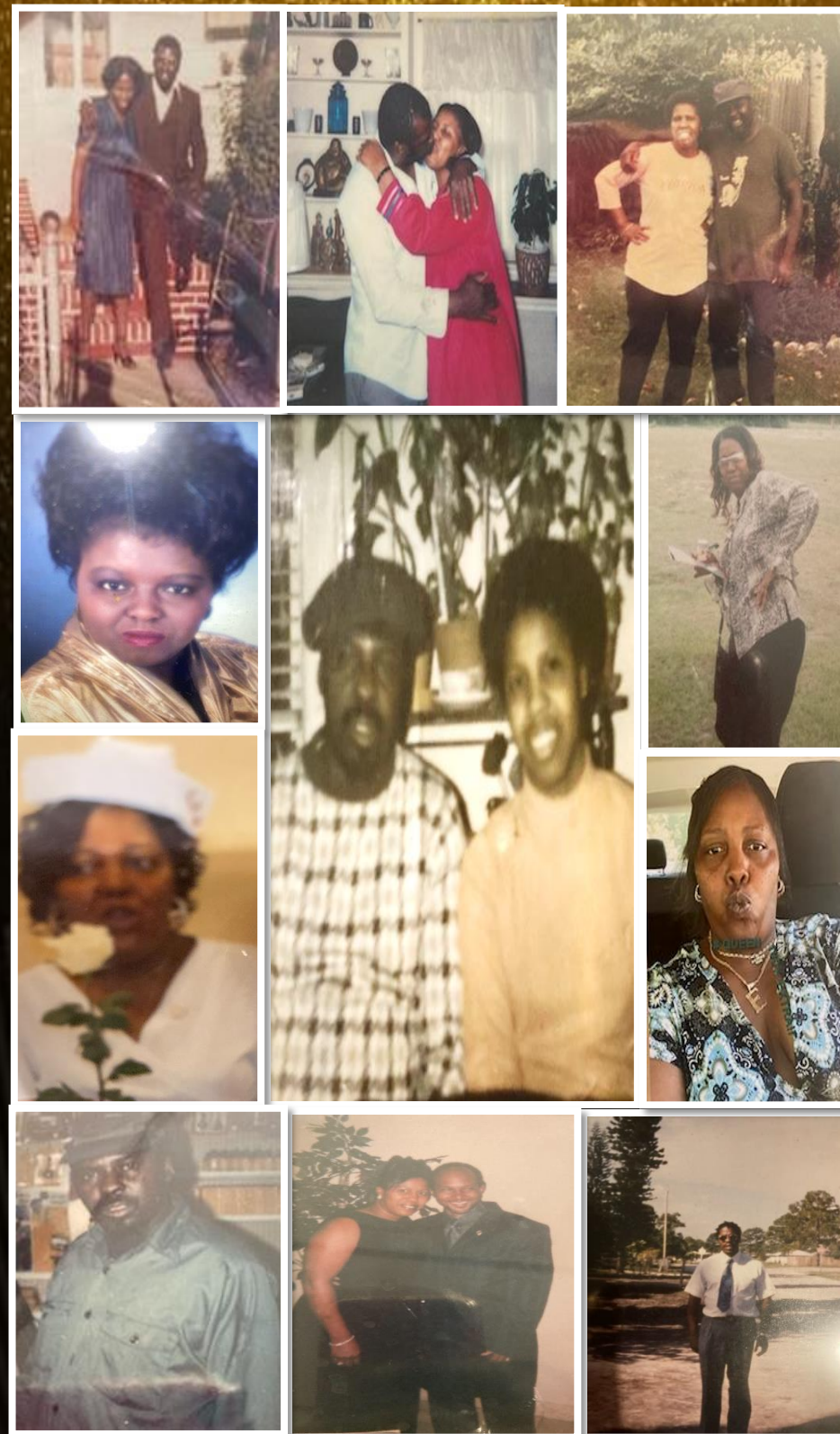
Reflections of Life
