Her Life's Journey

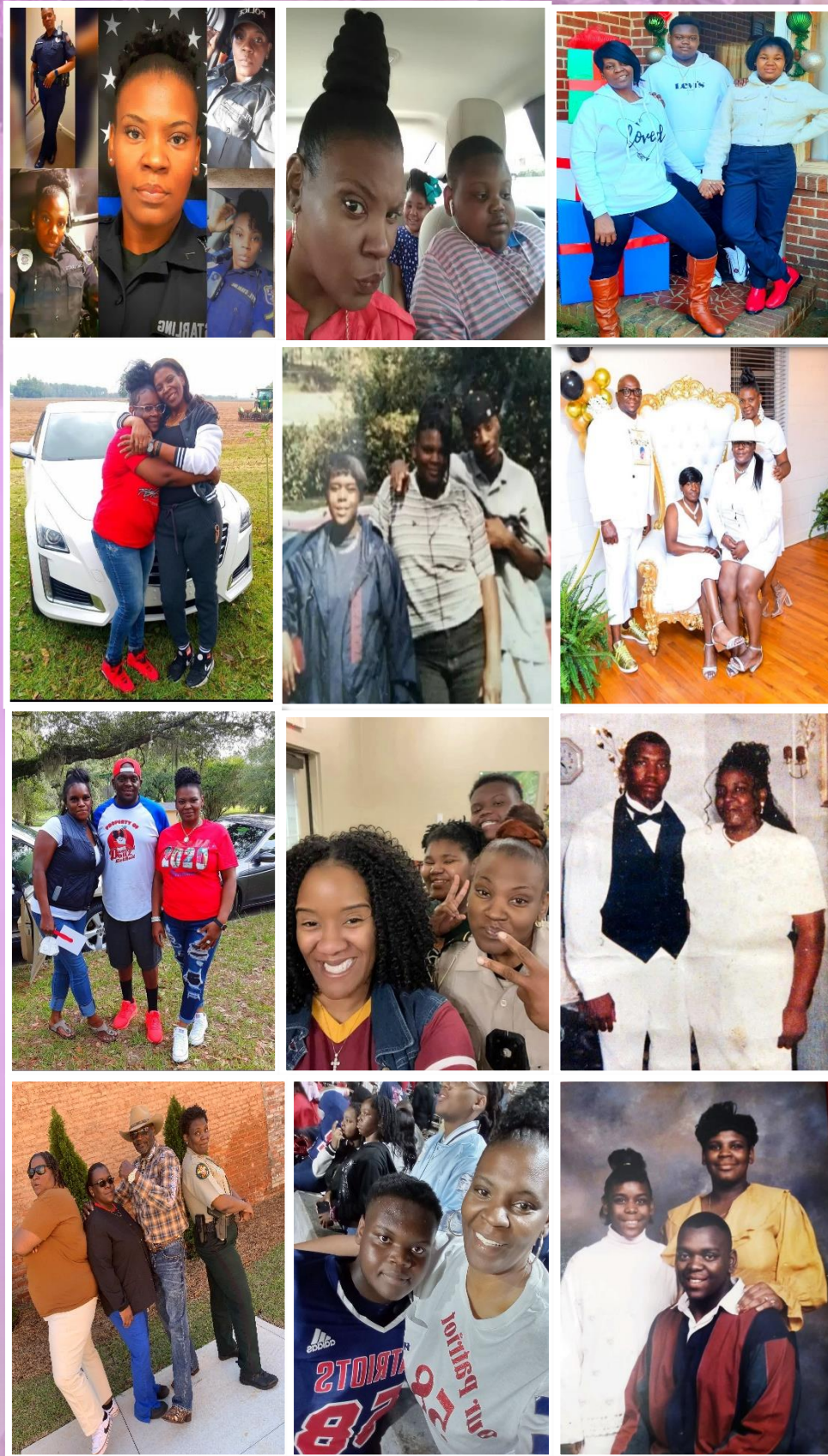
