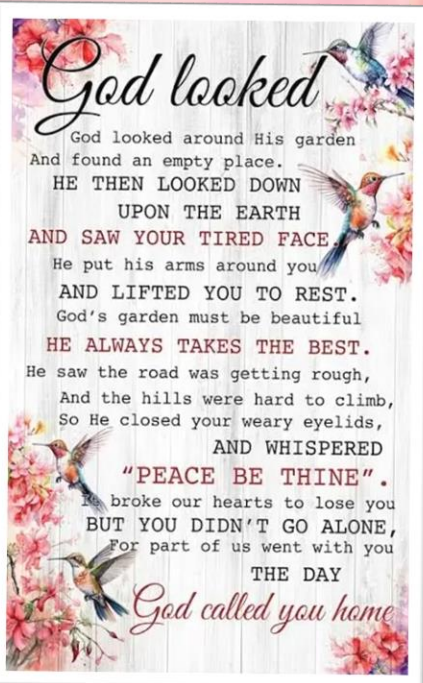
On Sunday, July 14, 2024, Angela departed her life at her residence in Cuthbert, GA. She was preceded in death by her parents.
