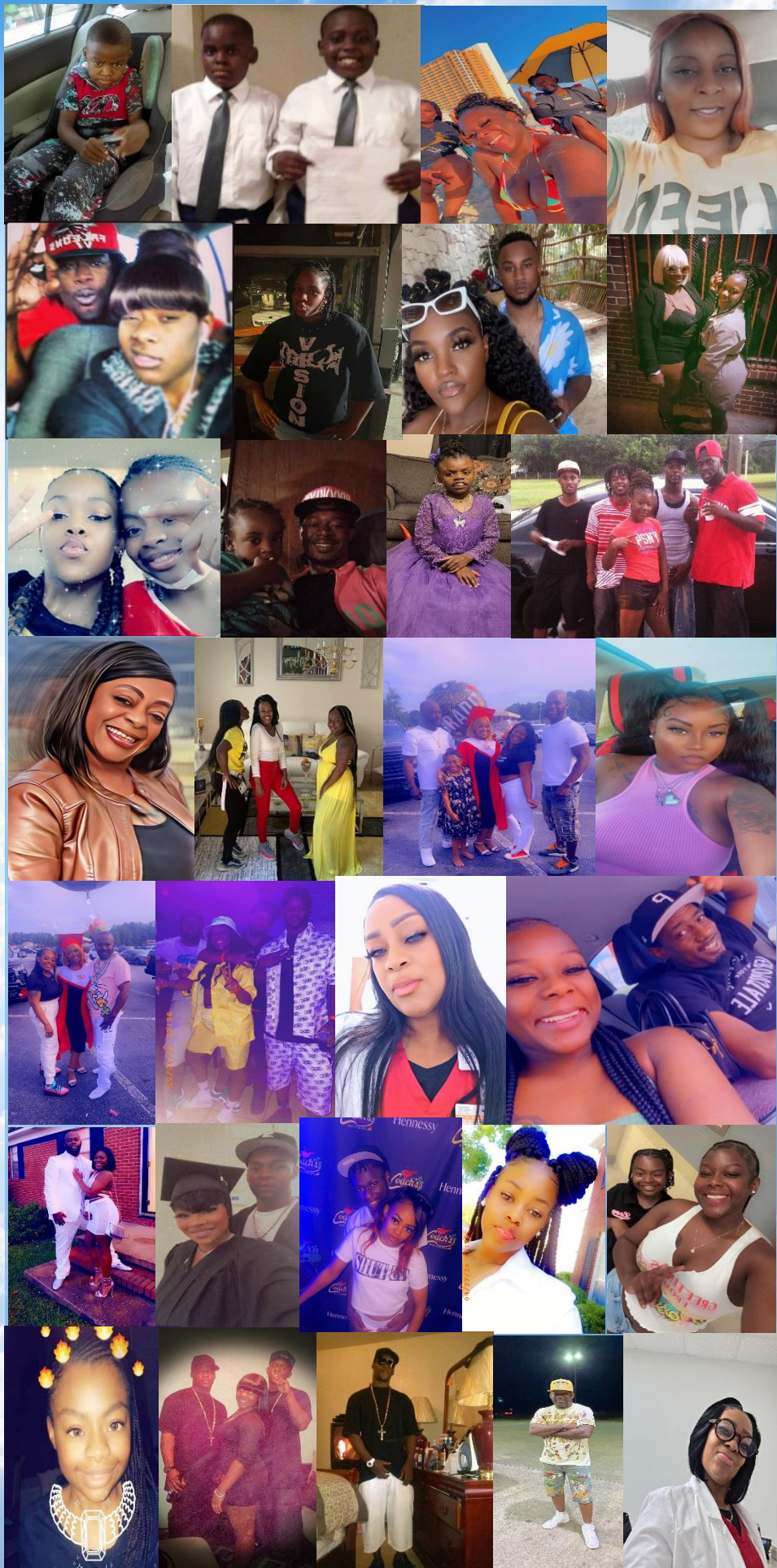

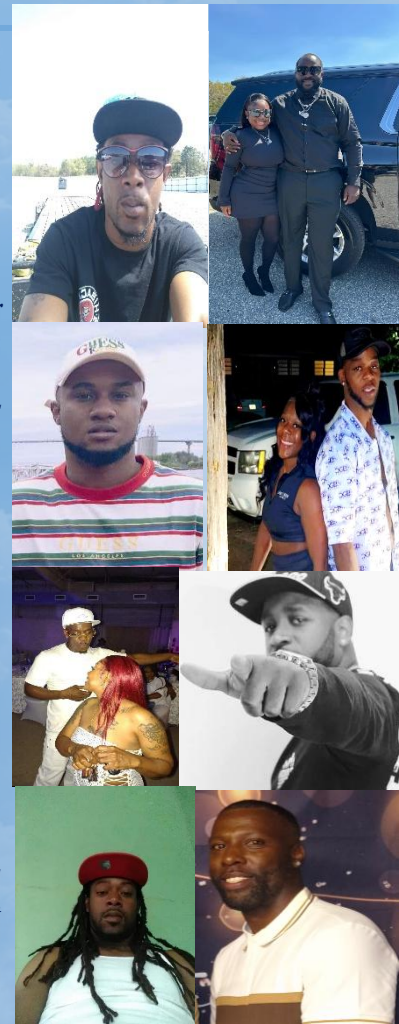
Heartfelt Farewell from the Brothers

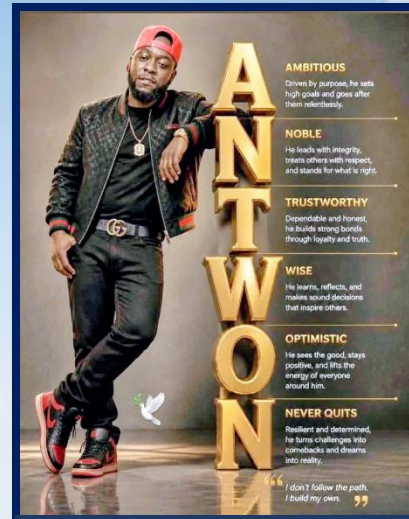
