OBITUARY

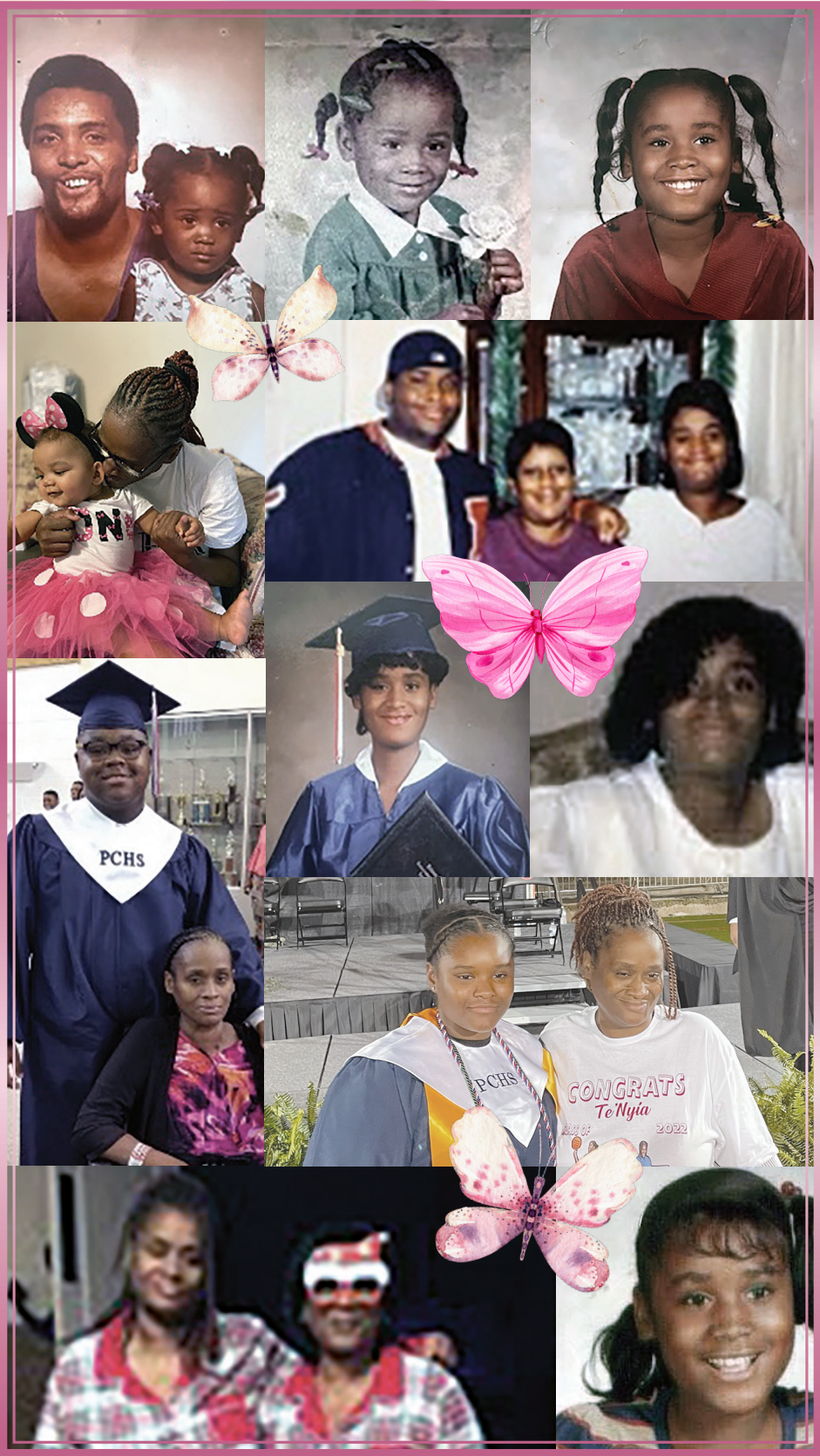
