

Obituary

Minister Sidney Marshall Reid, of Eatonton, Georgia, was born on April 16, 1948, and departed this life on September 16, 2025, at the age of 77.

Sidney was the beloved son of the late Willie James Adams and Frances Reid Dunn. He grew up in Eatonton and graduated from Butler Baker High School in 1968. Soon after, he answered the call to serve his country and proudly enlisted in the United States Army on April 16, 1968.

He served as a Personnel Specialist and was stationed at Fort Dix, New Jersey. During his military service, Sidney earned the National Defense Service Medal and completed training in Clerical and Military Justice procedures. He was honorably discharged under honorable conditions on May 14, 1969, after faithfully serving his nation.

Following his military service, Sidney went on to work with the Atlanta Water Works, where he was known for his dedication and strong work ethic. Beyond his career, he was deeply rooted in his community, where his faith, music, and service touched countless lives.
