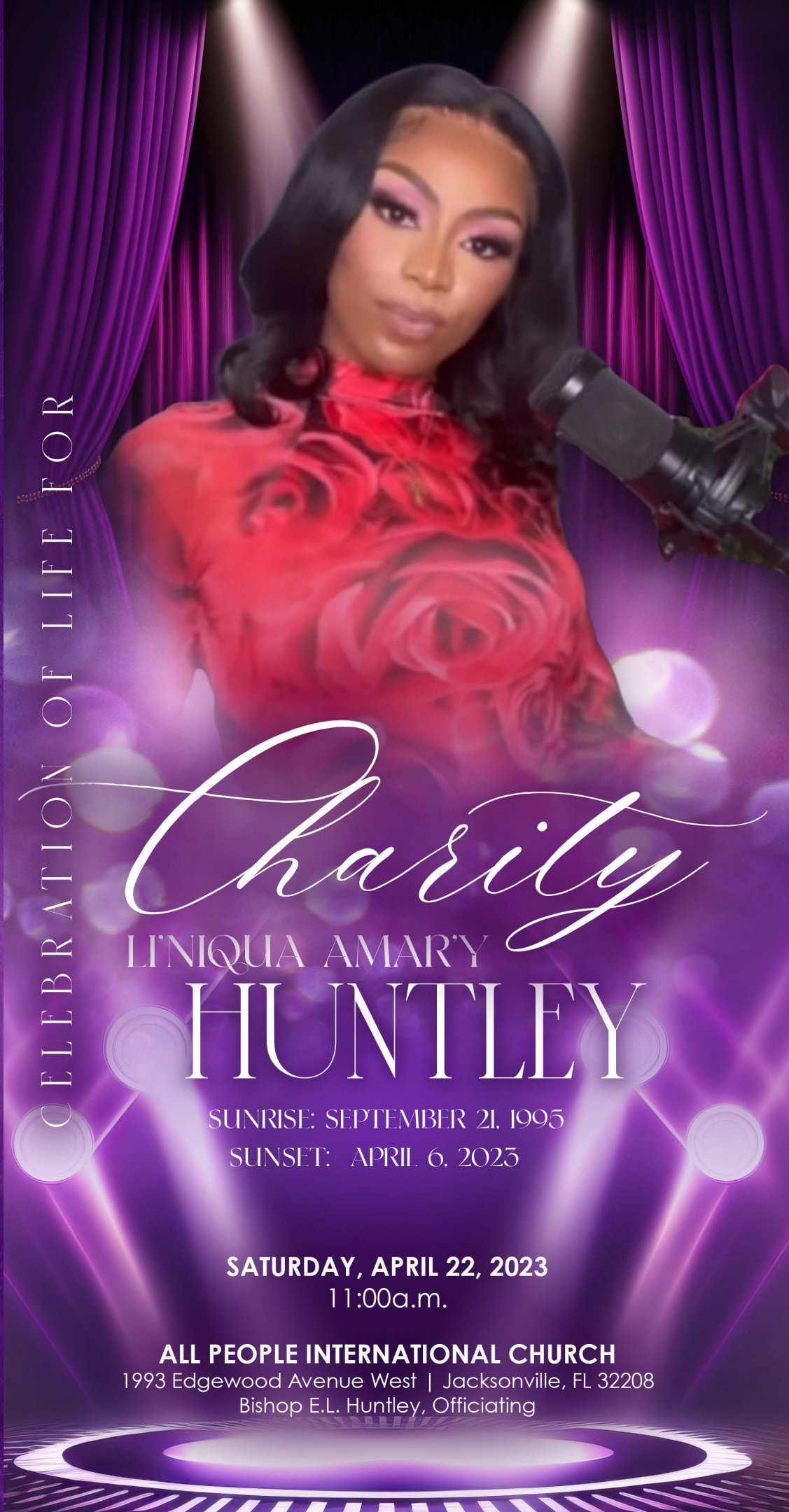

The life and legacy of Charity Li'Niqua Amar'y Huntley began September 21, 1995, as the first child to Mary La'Toya Huntley and James Lee Richardson Jr.

Charity attended local schools and graduated from Wolfson High School in 2013. Charity started her dance career at Lavilla School of the Arts, where she auditioned for and was accepted to perform in the Nutcracker. Charity was solicited throughout the community to perform in many capacities, including modeling, dancing, and singing. She cheered for the Jacksonville Giants and performed the National Anthem for the Jacksonville Shrimps. Charity promoted local small black businesses in the community, including the Jacksonville Expo and Women Empowerment. She was a jack of all trades.

Charity recorded two albums: "Sweet Nothings" (2018) and "Queenin" (2021). Her albums are currently on all streaming outlets (Spotify, YouTube, etc.).

Charity was the owner of two businesses, Uniquely Lush Body Butter and Oils, and Wanderlust Excursions Paradise Travels Group. She was a certified herbalist. While pursuing her entrepreneurial goals, she was also a dedicated full-time employee with Bank of America, and part-time employee with Emerald City Learning Center, Best Bet, and Bottles Up LLC.

Charity was a faithful member of Free Spirit Worldwide Assembly, where she was in the choir, dance ministry and an array of other roles.
