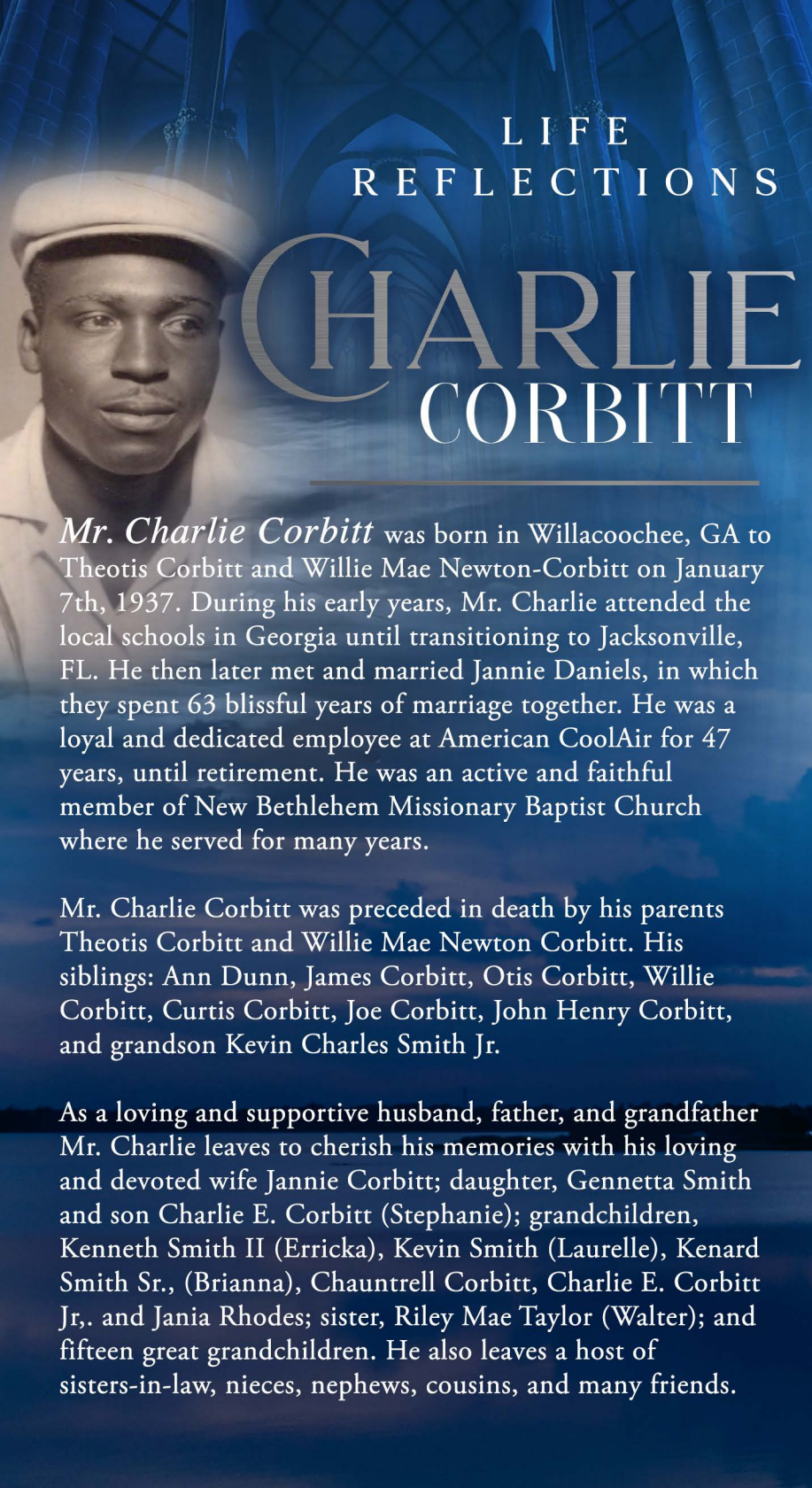

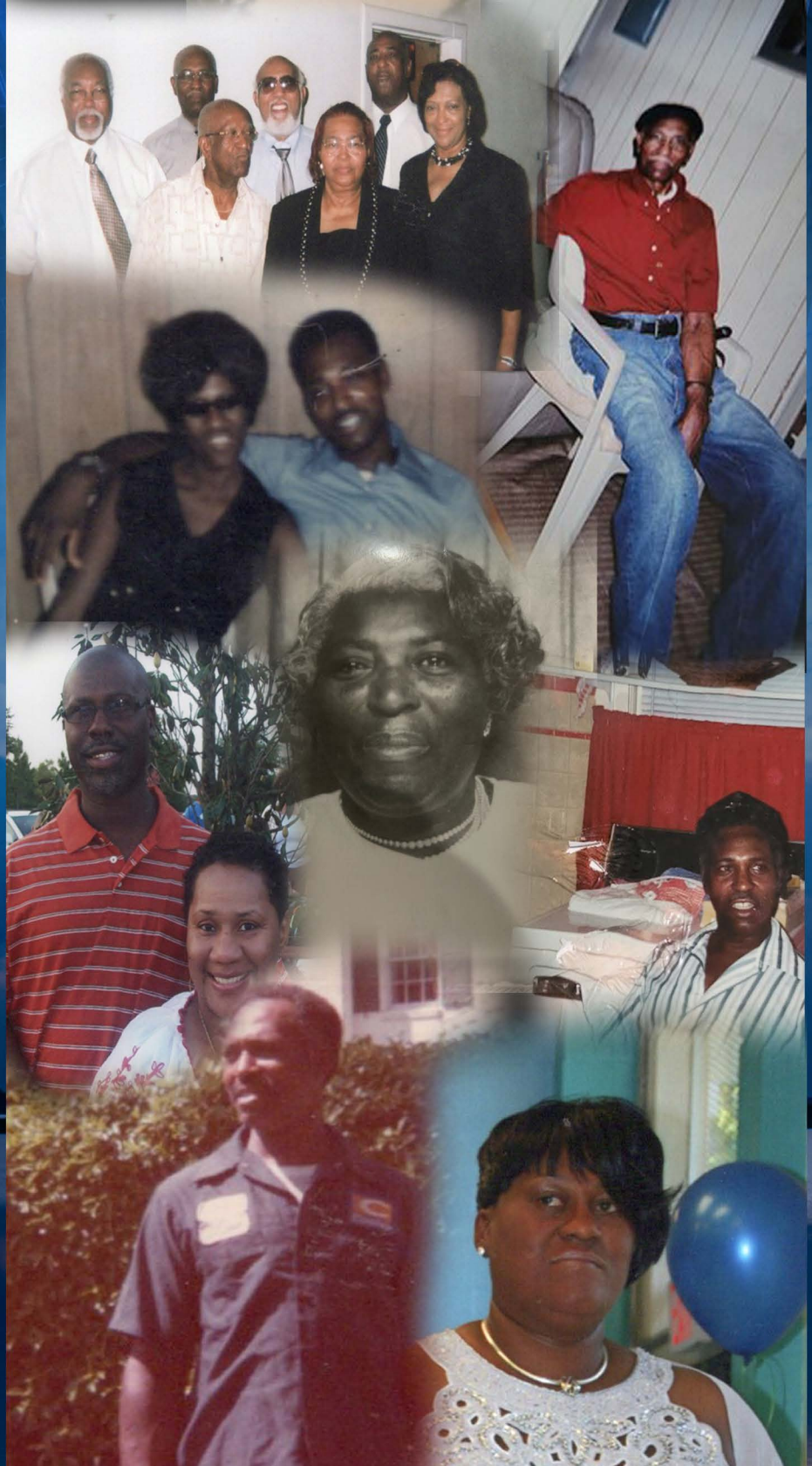
LIFE REFLECTIONS
