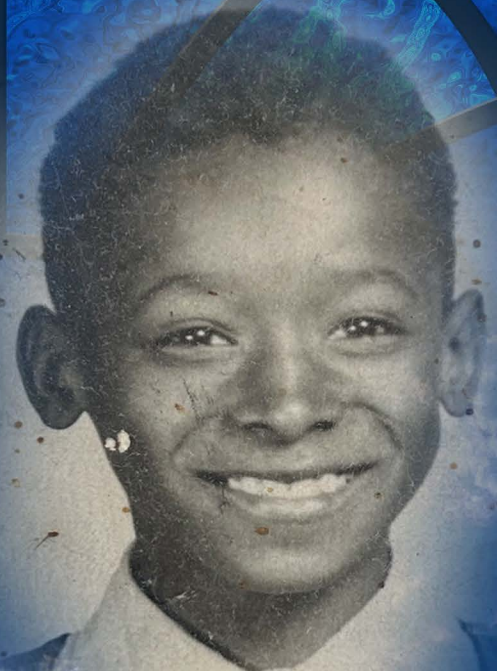

ANDY LEE DOMINECK affectionately known as “Lee Jr” or “Uncle Lee” was born to Andy and Idella Harris on July 23, 1941 in Rivertown, Georgia. He was the third of five children. Andy attended South Fulton High School, East Point Georgia. He made an eternal commitment to Jesus Christ at a very early age and became a member of Harris Chapel United Methodist Church in Palmetto, Georgia where he began singing in the choir and was the president of the single’s ministry.

Andy attended Chicago City College (Crane Campus), majoring in Journalism-English-and Prelaw. He was the Co-Editor of Crane Clarion Newspaper receiving numerous awards and honors. Andy graduated from Chicago State University in 1977 with relevant courses in Political Science. He was an investigator with the Chicago Transient Authority. He enjoyed working with young people, as a youth specialist and Counselor for Economic Opportunity Atlanta, Georgia.

Andy retired from CSX in customer service after twenty-eight years of dedicated service.

Andy was ordained a minister of the gospel in 1992 Carver Bible Institute under Reverend Willie R. Stark’s Pastoral Studies at J.S. Hammonds Missionary Baptist Church, Palmetto, Georgia.

Andy moved to Jacksonville, Florida in the latter 1990’s after settling he attended several local churches having started the children ministry at St. Mary’s Baptist Church now Renewed Life Ministries where Pastor Larry and Dr. Barbara Brown serves as pastors.
