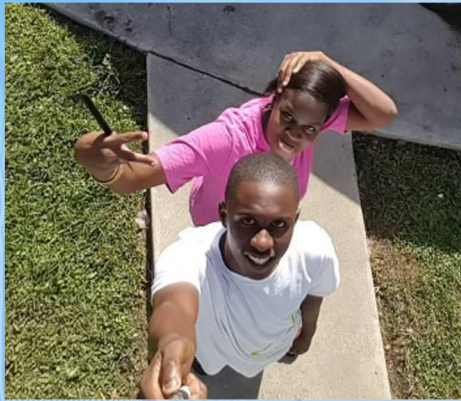

She asks nothing in return.

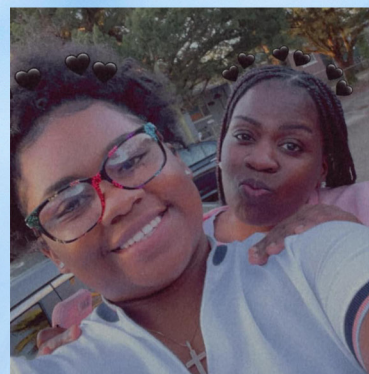
