At a very young age Corey received Christ as his Lord and Savior.

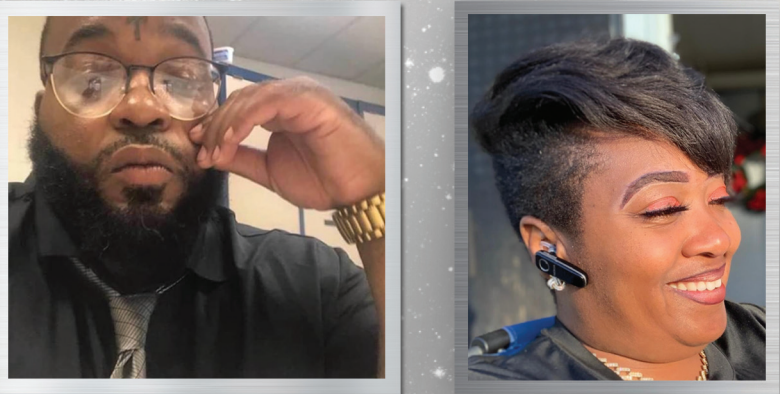
