All those I dearly love

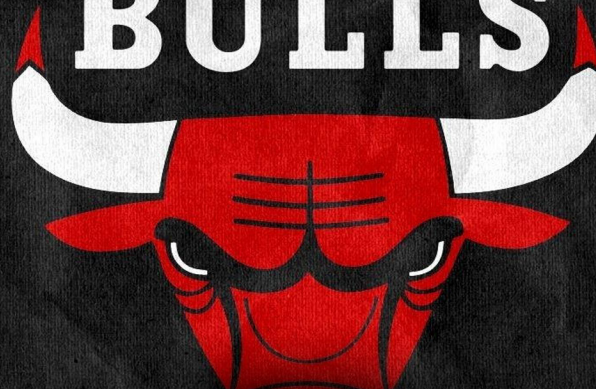
But when I walked through Heaven's Gates

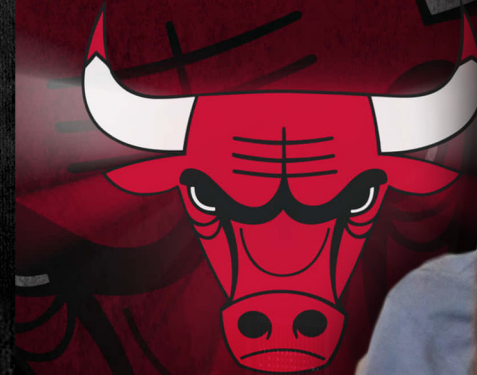

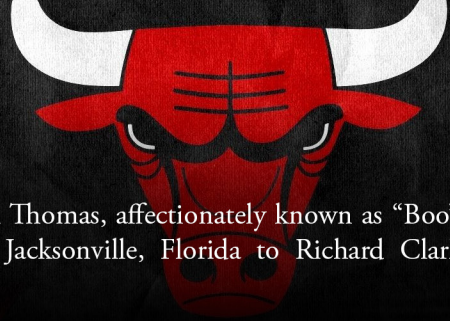

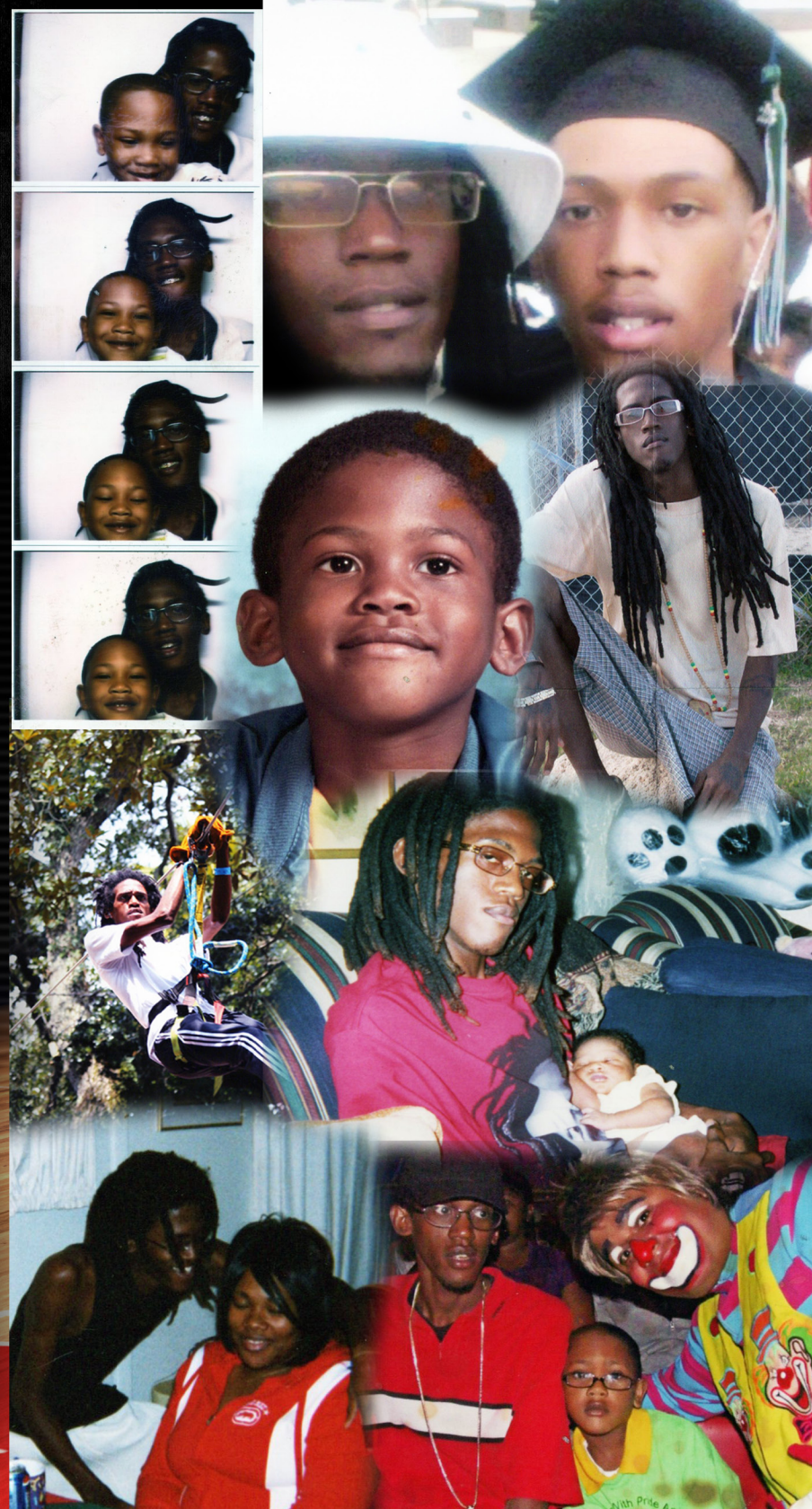
He worked as a Transportation Specialist where he transported patients to and from UF Shands in Jacksonville.
