

# LIFE REFLECTIONS

In the postwar era, 1947 is considered a period of economic expansion, new inventions, and the debut of Jackie Robinson in Major League Baseball. Apostle AD Meeks, the fifth of eleven children, was born to the proud parents of Jacob and Lula Mae Meeks of Farrell, Mississippi in 1947. Apostle Meeks was affectionately known as "Grown Man" due to his maturity and poise.

Apostle Meeks graduated from Coahoma Agriculture High School and furthered his education with an Associate of Arts Degree in Business Administration from Coahoma Junior College. With an innate desire to be a successful businessman, the Apostle enrolled and completed several career and certification courses at various business schools in Chicago, Illinois and Minneapolis, Minnesota. One of his childhood aspirations was to travel so the Apostle became employed as a Greyhound Bus driver for sixteen years. However, he started working as early as fourteen years old for SafeWay Grocery store and purchased his first car in high school. The Apostle was an overachiever in pursuit of his dreams and goals.

A firm believer of the Holy Scriptures, "that many are called; however, few are chosen" the Apostle testified that he received an invocation to preach the gospel and compel souls to come to Christ at the tender age of fourteen. Therefore, knowing the will of God for his life, the Apostle took a keen interest in studying the Word of God and learning to hear God's voice. Apostle Meeks' ministerial career began when he became a member of St. James Temple C.O.G.I.C. where he served faithfully as a minister under the honorable, late, Bishop T.T. Scott of the Northern Mississippi Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction.

In obedience to the Holy Spirit, Apostle Meeks relocated to the Sunshine State in the city of Jacksonville, Florida with his beautiful wife, L.B. Meeks (high school sweetheart), three sons and one daughter on the way. They later completed their family with six children including three sons and three daughters. The favor of God was upon the Apostle, he served as a minister under the late Bishop Williams at Southside Church of God in Christ. Shortly thereafter, Apostle Meeks served under the late Bishop C.D. Kinsey at Greater Holy Temple. This Godly occupation afforded him opportunities to meet Jacksonville city officials and act as a positive advocate of change in the community.

In 1980, Apostle Meeks began his pastorate at the Awakening Power of God's Word Ministries, Inc., formerly known as the United Church of God in Christ. He pastored hundreds and impacted thousands within the forty-four years of ministry. The Apostle served as Chief Overseer, Pastor and Spiritual Adviser to at least eight ministries (six ministries were started by the Apostle and numerous Pastors installed) within the following locations: California; Racine, Wisconsin; West Palm Beach, Florida; Jacksonville, Florida; The Bahamas; Atlanta, Georgia and Folkston, Georgia. In the 80's, the Apostle held a Crusade for Christ at the Jacksonville Coliseum and hundreds attended. The Apostle has always had an overwhelming desire to preach the Gospel and compel the lost to come to Christ. Throughout his ministerial career – the Apostle could be heard weekly on the airwaves of WCGL 1360. There are many testimonies of God using the Apostle in the areas of healing, prophecy, deliverance, salvation, marriage restoration and financial breakthroughs. The Apostle preached with a strong conviction that holiness without, no man will see the Lord.

It was the Apostle's dream to build a new place of worship for The Awakening Power of God's Word Ministries. God granted the Apostle's desire with a new sanctuary that was built and is in the greater, northwestern section of Jacksonville. The Apostle was a man of faith and firmly believed "but without faith, it is impossible to please him[ God]; for he that cometh to God must believe that he is and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him" Hebrews 11:6. The Apostle preserved and continued in the work of God for the advancement of the Kingdom.
