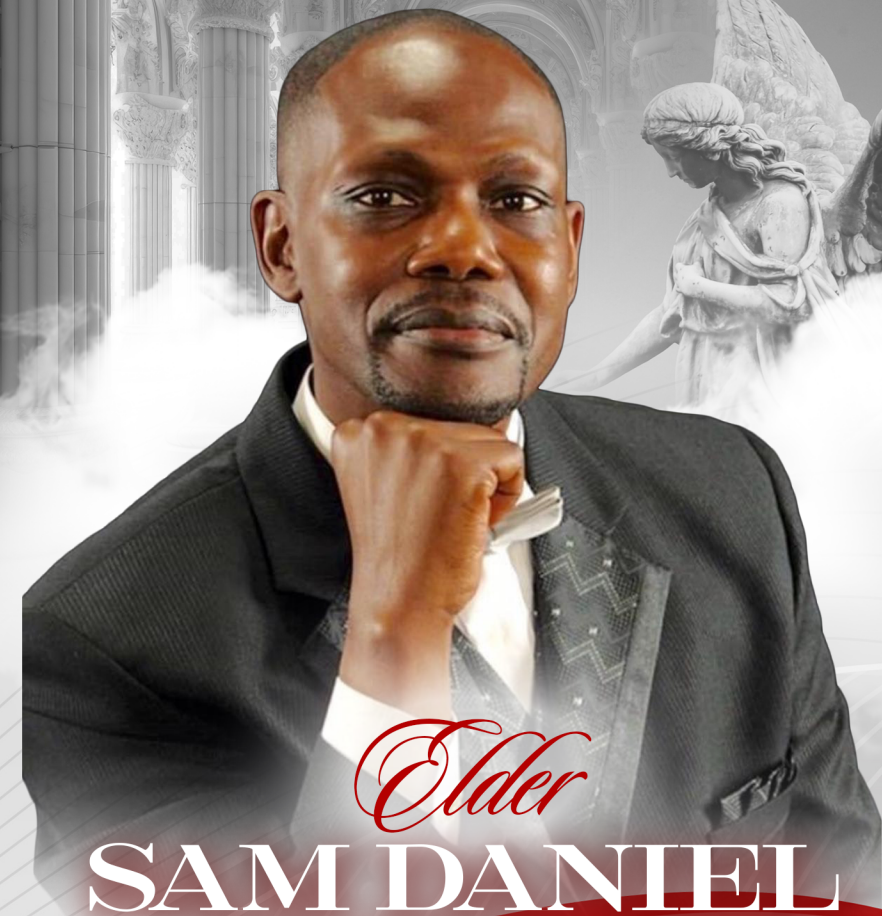

SAM DANIEL COOK, JR.

Sam Daniel Cook, Jr. was born on April 6, 1971, to the union of Sam Cook, Sr. and Annette Cook in Jacksonville, Florida. He was the first of three children. He attended high school at Jean Ribault in Jacksonville, Florida. After high school, he attended Florida State University where he received his bachelor's degree in industrial system engineering. Sam later received his master's degree in industrial system engineering and business management and operations. For over twenty years, Sam worked in Chicago, Illinois; Bowling Green, Kentucky; Nashville, Tennessee; Knoxville, Tennessee and Lynchburg, Virginia.

Sam was raised in the Faust Temple #2 Church Of God In Christ, under the leadership of his father and Superintendent, Sam Cook. He accepted the Lord in his life at the young age of fourteen years old and was called into ministry at the age of seventeen years old. Sam was known for his singing and his role in choir directing.
