LIFE STORY

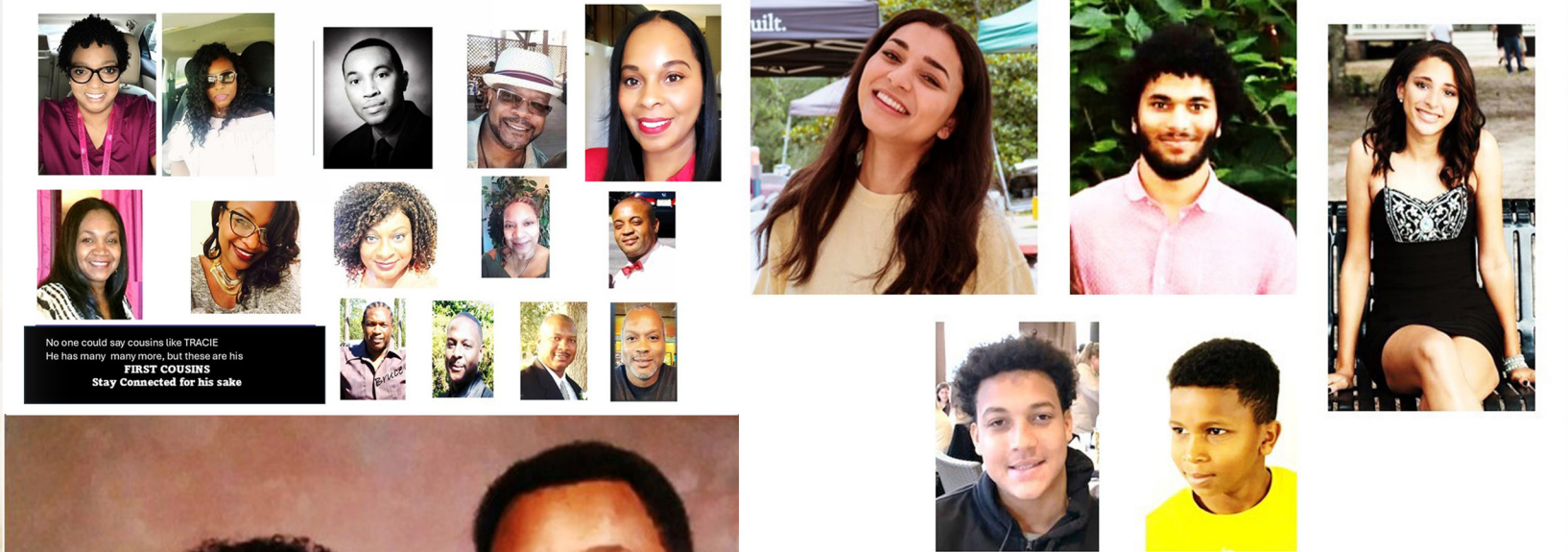
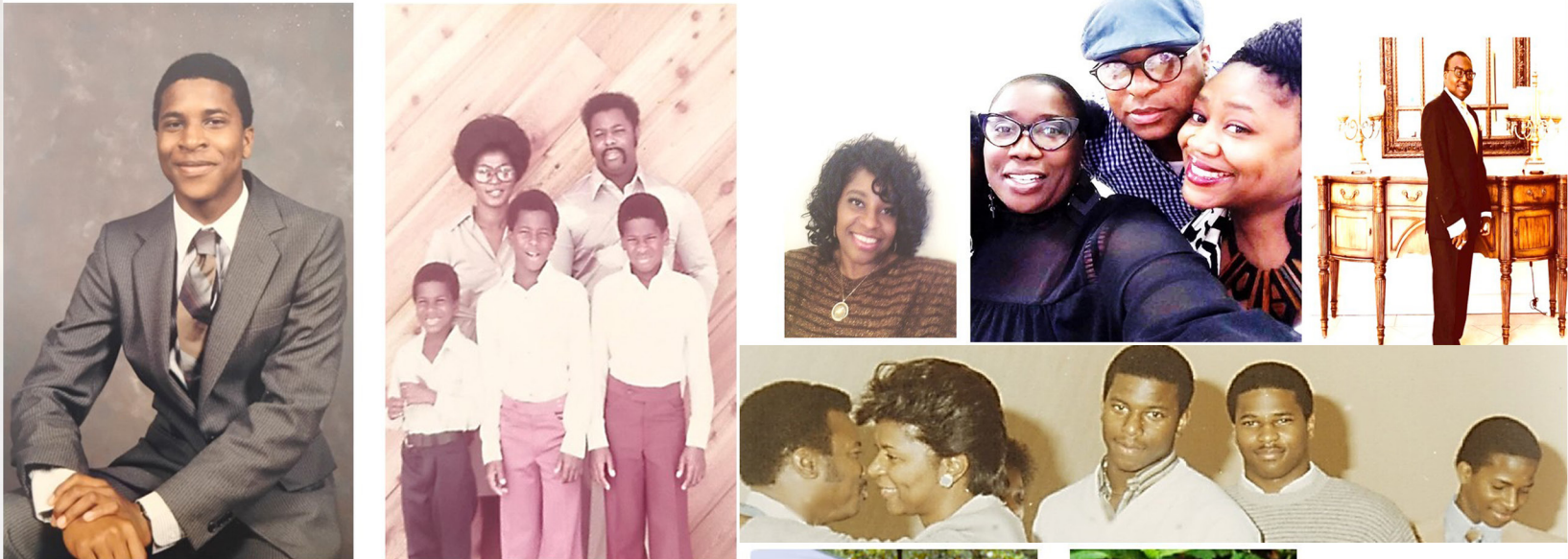
