# LIFE & LEGACY

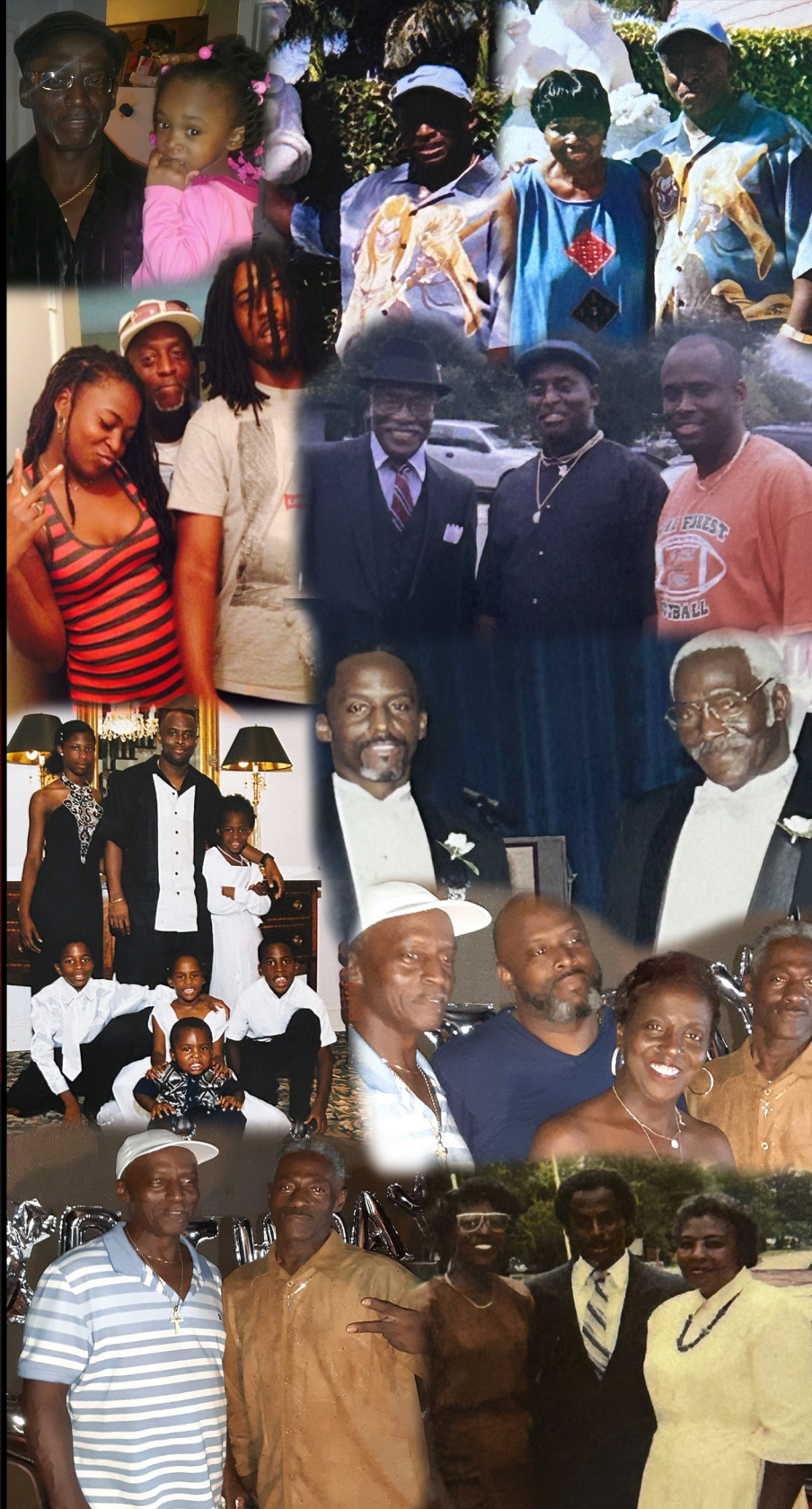
