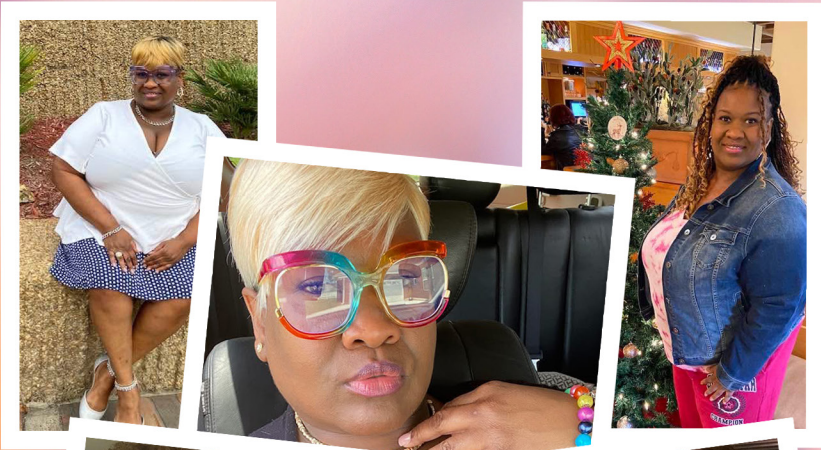
Tara's STORY
