that it was time I go.

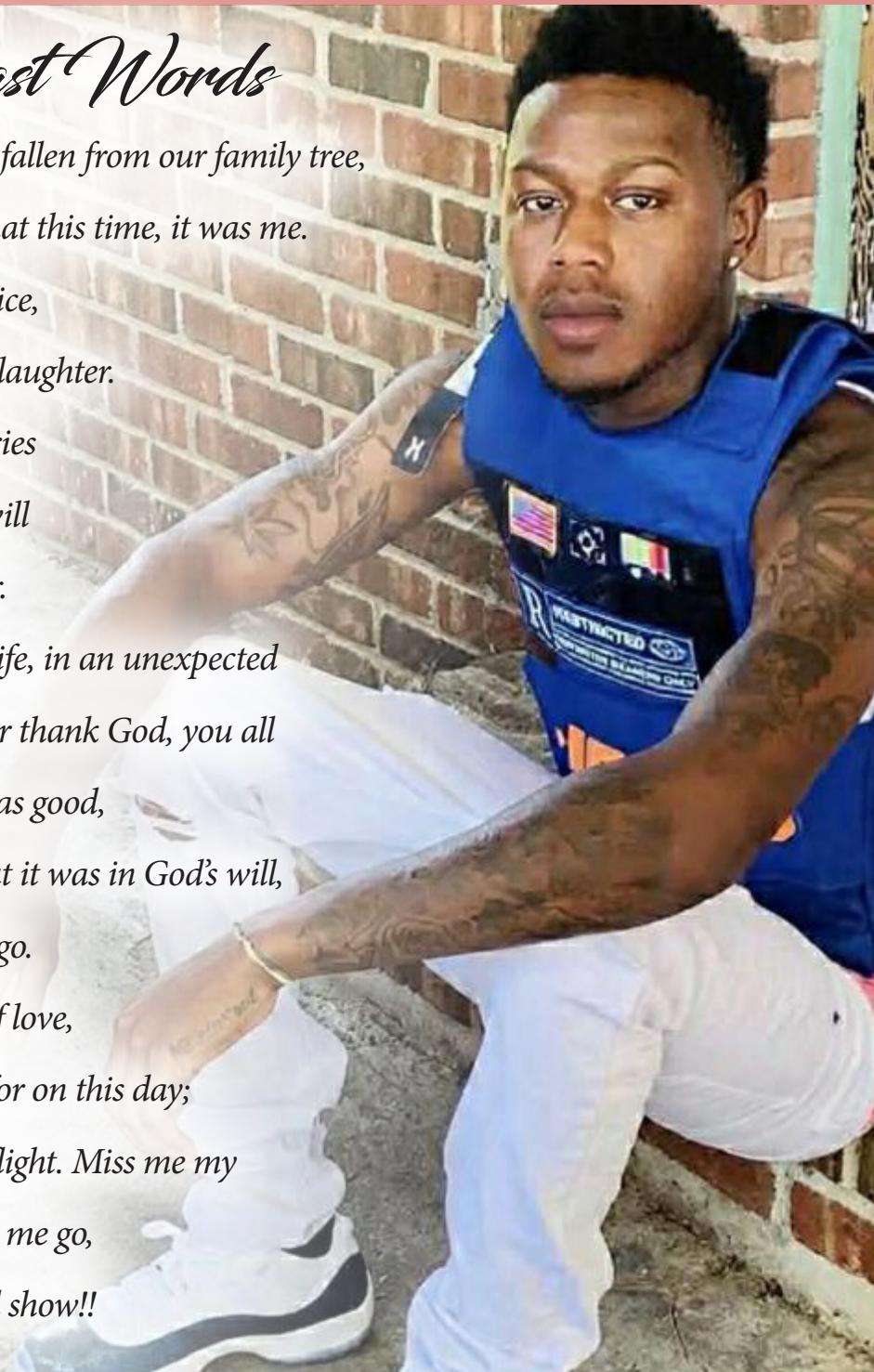
