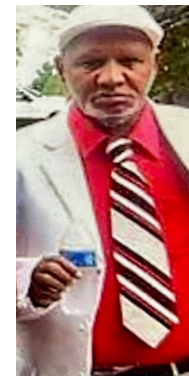
David attended public school at Newbold High School. He retired from Century Furniture in Hickory, North Carolina.
