

## Life Reflections

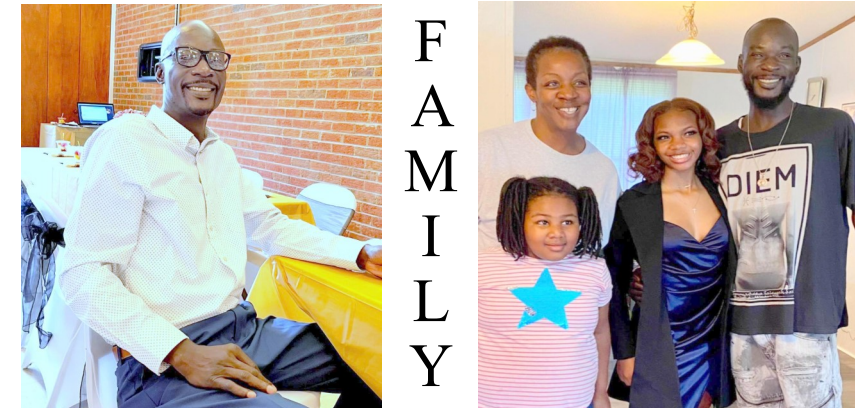
