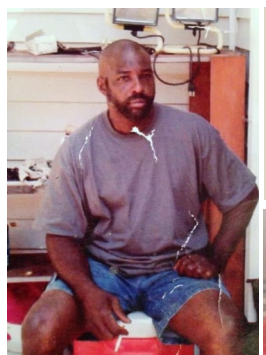
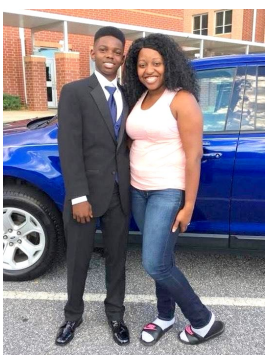
Bettie attended Newbold High School. She retired from Cochrane Furniture. She was a member Refuge Church of God of Prophecy.
