For I am resting in His care.

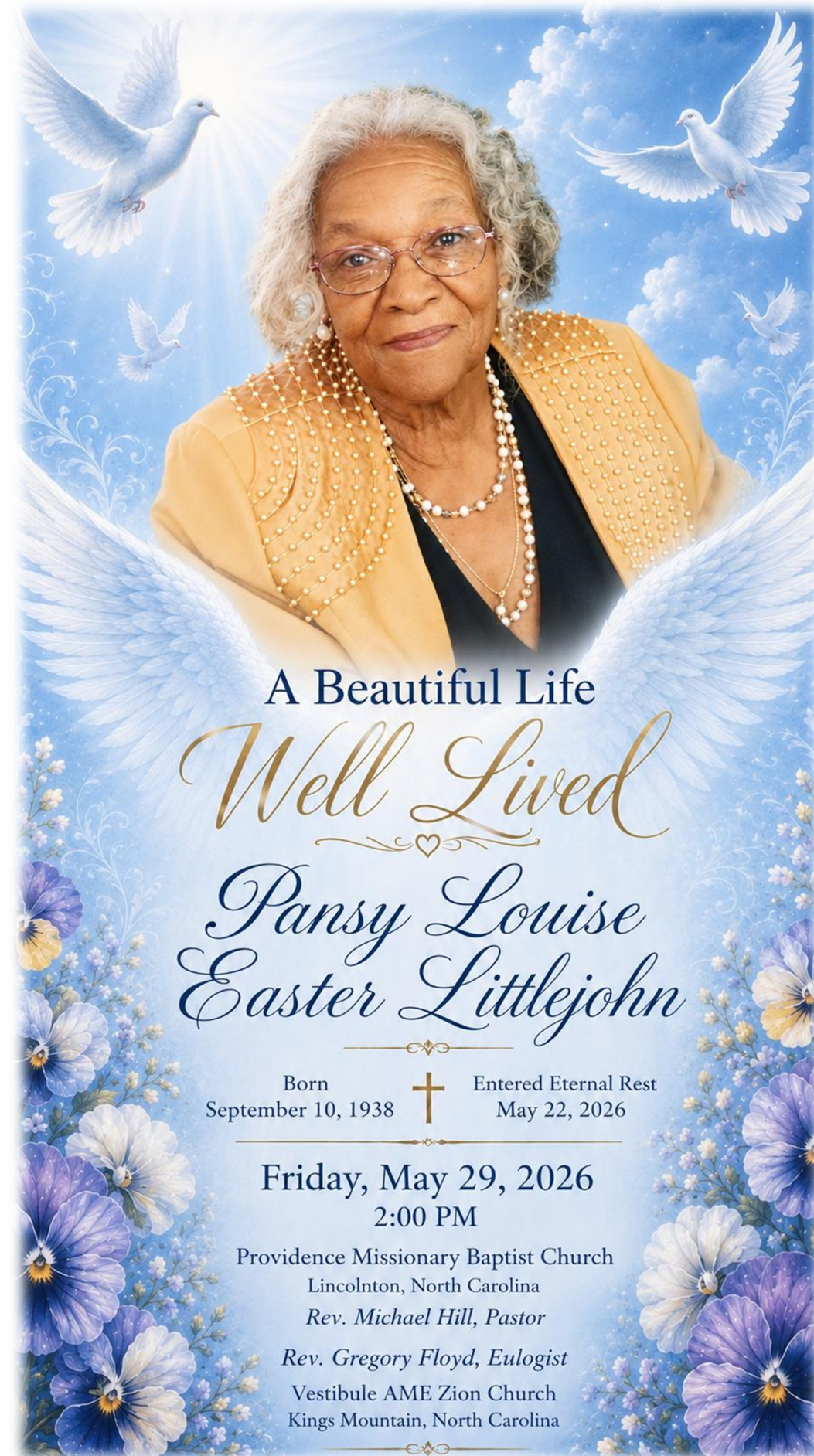

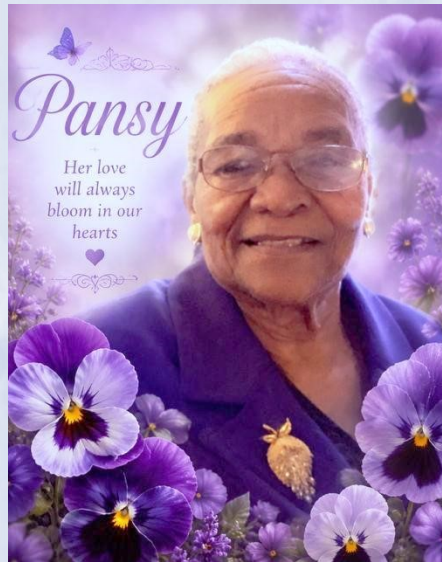
