

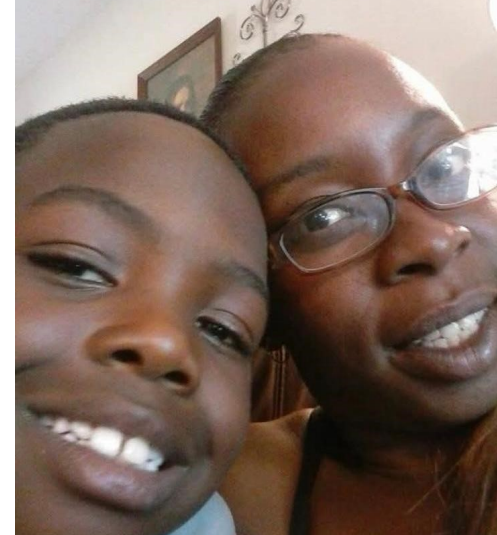
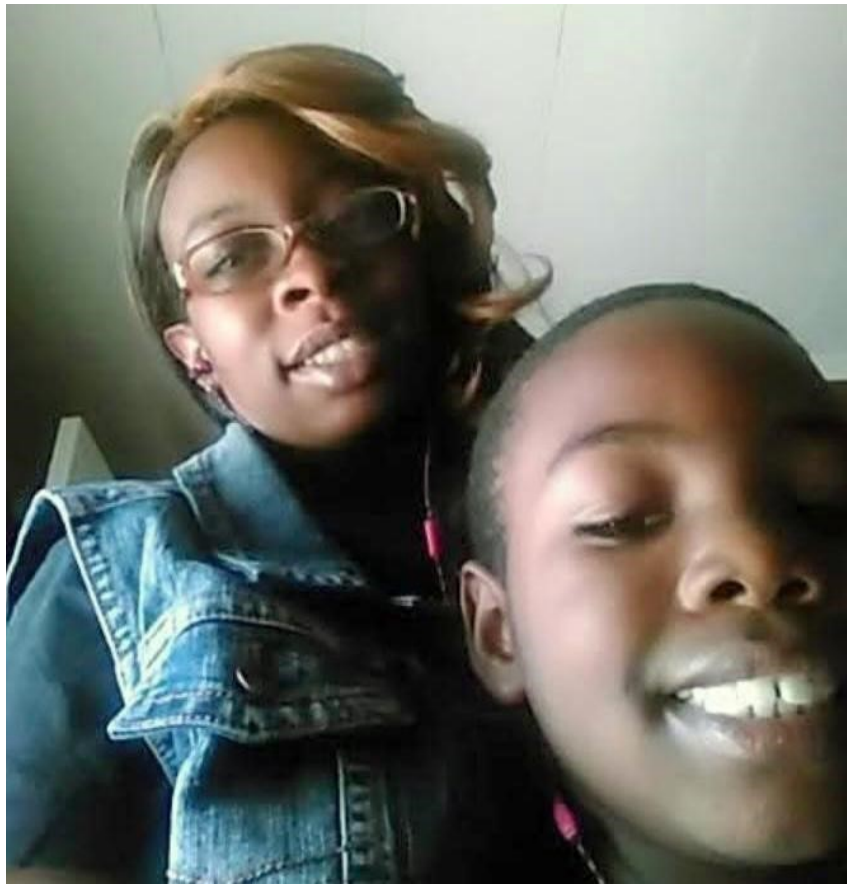
JOURNEY OF LIFE
