Nora L. Waller was born Nov. 13, 1928, to Clifford and Rosie Bell, in Youngstown, OH. She attended Youngstown Public School and graduated from East High School. Later she went back to school and graduated in nursing, she used her acquired knowledge working at several hospitals within the Youngstown area. Civic minded, she became a member of the Order of the Eastern Stars in the late 1950's. She was of the Baptist faith and became a member of Beulah Baptist Church, serving in several positions.
