A Hero's Welcome

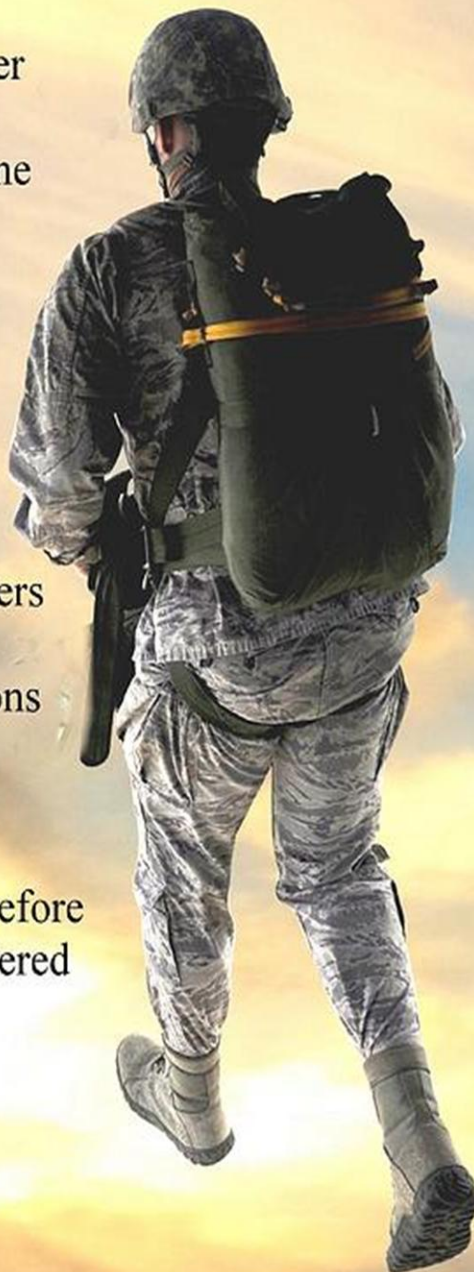
